Dear Parents,

You are now in the first term of the first year of your child's school career. How exciting this must be for both you and your child.

For your child to do well at school, the first thing you must do is provide your child with the best breakfast you can afford, every single day. It provides the child with energy to meet the work load "head on" and be successful.

Please give your child a sandwich every day for first break. Biscuits and cake are NOT nourishing. Neither are Bakers breakfast biscuits. Fruit, nuts, sliced vegetables with peanut butter dip and yoghurt would be acceptable as well.

Cake and biscuits, chips and sweets are only to be consumed at second break.

Money for tuck must be kept in a purse that you may purchase at the school for R30. (write your order in the message book) Tuck may only be bought at second break and after school. The money form is NOT for tuck. No fizzy drinks may be brought to school (NO coke, NO Fanta, NO fizzy drinks at all, not even sparkling water.

Please remember, your child must be in FULL SCHOOL UNIFORM everyday with the exception of birthdays when they may wear civvies.

You requested this school, so please adhere to the necessary requirements. Yellow Golf Shirt (available at the office for R120 each)

Navy Blue Shorts (obtainable from Jet, Pep, Checkers Hyper)

White takkies and White ankle socks or Dark coloured sandals (No Black school shoes)

School Hat - the first hat is issued to your child as part of the registration fee. The hat must be worn to school EVERY day. If the hat is left at home, a fine of R1 per day will be issued.

If the hat is lost, R60 must be paid to replace it.

Nail Polish - CUTEX - is not part of school uniform and no hair extensions or hair pieces. Hair must be worn straight back.

Your child has been issued with a Message Book. This book must be checked and signed every day as proof that you have looked through it for important information. Please see that this book is covered and kept in a plastic bag or file as the juice from your child's bottle may leak and damage the Message book.

Please see that the bottle does not leak.

On the last two days of every month the Grade R classes will have a Civvies and Hot Dog Day. They will pay R20.00 to wear civvies and get a hot dog. This is a fund raiser for Grade R only. It is also a Fine Motor exercise. The R20 must be handed in first thing in the morning. Please indicate on the Money Form in the front of the Message Book.

In conclusion let me request that your child is put to bed by 8 o'clock every night, that you read to your child for 5 minutes every night. . . . . and lastly, please DO NOT teach your child to write capital letters, only lower case letters.
