- 1) On Tuesday 14 February, learners will be allowed to wear 'civvies' (something RED with jeans/skirt) for VALENTINES DAY at a cost of R5-00 to be paid to their register teacher.



There will be a variety of gifts to be sold ranging in price from R8 to R30. In addition, we will also be selling delicious 'Valentines Cup Cakes.' Orders for cupcakes need to be placed on Monday 13 February. These cakes will be handed out to the learners on Tuesday. Arrangements can be made to deliver a cupcake to a valentine, anonymously.

The prices for cupcakes are as follows:

- R5-00 for a plain cupcake.
- R7-00 for a cupcake with icing.
- R10-00 for an iced cupcake and a message card for your valentine.



The money must be paid to the register teacher when placing the order. The other valentine items will be sold at break on Monday and Tuesday morning. Please support this fund raiser!

- 2) We are requesting parents and transport drivers to adhere to the rules of the road in the morning and after school. A reminder that **Athlone Avenue is a 'One Way Street'** between the hours of 07:00 and 08:00 and after school between 13:00 and 14:30. Sutherland Road, at the back of the school is not a one way and therefore parents are not to cross the road and park in the opposite direction. The Scholar Patrol members are on duty during these periods and they are there to protect the children while crossing the road.
- 3) **'Read Right'** Reading Classes. Does your child battle with reading? Are you often told they are under-achieving or not reaching their potential? Poor reading skills often lead to children not doing as well as they could be in other areas (including maths). 'Read Right' is a reading programme which aims at

improving your child's reading skills so that they can improve their performance in all other learning areas as well as to develop a joy for reading.

Classes are held at Strubenvale Primary after school on Monday to Thursday and at Selcourt Primary on Saturday mornings.

The cost is R250-00 per month for one class a week OR, R400-00 per month for two classes a week. (+ R100-00 yearly registration fee).
