RE: CATCHING-UP SCHOOL WORK OVER THE NEXT TWO WEEKS

We would like to express our sincere gratitude for all your hard work, dedication and input in your child/children's education during the previous nine weeks.

A decision amongst our Foundation Phase teachers, the HOD, Mrs Setter, and our Principal, Mr Ramos, was made that there will be no further work uploaded on the Strubies webpage from the 22nd of June until the learners return on the 6th of July.

Please use the time wisely to insure that all the work that was published on the Strubies webpage are up to date. All the work in the DBE books and homework file should also be completed. There will be no time to catch up the work when the learners return to school.

We would like you to please put all the work that your child has done during the lockdown period in plastic sleeves in a Lever Arch file or a Flip File. Each subject according to the weeks in its own plastic sleeve.

All the files and plastic sleeves will be returned at the end of the year. The Arch Lever files can be used in Grade Two as well.

Please do not buy any other books or stationery now as we will hand these out when the learners return to school. All extra stationery and books will be sent home at the end of the year.

We have received the new "Revised Curriculum Teaching Plans" from the Department of Basic Education. These teaching plans are divided into 22 weeks, however, due to the fact that we are only seeing the learners on alternative days, we only have 11 weeks to teach the learners.

More details about the return of the other grades on the 6th of July 2020 will be posted soon. Please look at the information with regards to the return dates of groups posted on this website to see where your child is placed and the days that he/she will be attending classes. Please contact Mrs. Wheeler at 011 812 1632 from the 2nd of July 2020 to confirm that you have seen the grouping and dates applicable to your child.

The learners will receive work that must be completed on the day that they are not attending school. The work will be marked the next day and corrections will be made.

All learners must wear a mask on the first day of school. New masks will be handed out in class.

Please make sure that the learners rest well, as we will have to work relentlessly to complete all work as per the teaching plan that was given by the Department of Basic Education.
