Week 7 work and requirements explained:

1. Mathematics: Week 6: Symmetry worksheet memo check.

Week 7: Symmetry art activities. Choose from the crowns, butterflies or pizza's. You do not have to do everything. Choose the pictures and paste the one side exactly like the other to make it look symmetrical. If you can not print re-draw the pictures and colour them in.

2. English: Week 7 and 8: phonics (same sound differant spelling) words for spelling and 10 sentences with flashcards (compulsory) to assist learners with spelling and decoding of words, as well as Bingo game (not compulsory). DBE book pg 116-119, Reading of the new bigbook given. Learners can read it on a computer, cellphone or tablet with a pdf programme. No need to print it out.

3. Afrikaans: Week 6 Spelling (oe) with memo to check answers.

Week 7: Spelling (pl-) Practise writing the spelling words in the Homeworkbook or seperate paper with the given sentences. "pl-" sound worksheet. Use the extra worksheet given with the meaning of the words.

Afrikaans: Reading of two new stories given. Learners can read it on a computer, cellphone or tablet with a pdf programme. No need to print it out.

Note NB: All spelling for English and Afrikaans and sentences must be done in the children's homework books or on seperate paper if they do not have their homework books with them.

4. Life skills: Week 6: Insects -How they help and harm us:
check memo for the worksheets.

Week 7: 4 New theme: Life cycles- complete the worksheets.

5. Lastely: Please keep to a routine at home and divide the work equally on a daily basis, so that you or your child do not feel overwhelmed.
