1. Mathematics wk 8: check memo.

2. English: Week 7 and 8: phonics (same sound different spelling)

Check the answers from the given memo for last week's worksheet.

Wk 9 - Complete the 2 book review worksheets on any book that you have read during the lockdown. You may use your own books or the books that you had to read on a weekly basis as part of the "lockdown home programme" from the school website.

DBE book pg 126-133 Arabella poem worksheet- Draw pictures in each block to show understanding of the poem. Read the passage: "A butterfly smile". No need to print it out. Read it from a cellphone, tablet or computer.

3. Afrikaans: Week 9: Rhyming words worksheets. Read the given poems and circle the rhyming words in them. Reading of the story given, make the frog. Learners can read it on a computer, cellphone or tablet with a pdf programme. No need to print it out.

Note NB: All spelling for English and Afrikaans and sentences must be done in the children's homework books or on separate paper if they do not have their homework books with them.

4. Life skills: Week 8 recycling worksheets memo check.

Week 9: Complete the 2 recycling worksheets. Write a sentence next to each picture on how we can reduce at home and re-use water. DBE pg 60,61

5. Lastely: Please keep to a routine at home and divide the work equally on a daily basis, so that you or your child do not feel overwhelmed.
