Week 3 work and requirements explained:

1. Mathematics: Memo for wk 1 and 2 Awesome learning booklet.

Please check your answers and assist learners with corrections.

New Mathematics only booklet for week 3 and 4. Memo will be sent in week 5 again for checking.

2. English: Week 1-3 phonics (ou,ow) words for spelling and 10 sentences with flashcards (compulsory) to assist learners with spelling and decoding of words, as well as Bingo spelling game (optional). Learners all know how to play. They colour the spelling word that is called out.

Week 3 phonics (au,aw) words for spelling and 10 sentences with flashcards (compulsory) to assist learners with spelling and decoding of words, as well as Bingo spelling game (optional). Learners all know how to play. They colour the spelling.

Reading of bigbook given. Learners can read it on a computer, cellphone or tablet with a pdf programme. No need to print it out.

3. Afrikaans: Week 1 and 2 Spelling vowels (,ao) with memo to check answers. Practise writing the words in the Homeworkbook or separate paper with the given sentences.

Week 3: Spelling vowels (e,i,u) with memo to check answers. Practise writing the words in the Homeworkbook or separate paper with the given sentences.

Reading of bigbook given. Learners can read it on a computer, cellphone or tablet with a pdf programme. No need to print it out.

Note NB: All spelling for English and Afrikaans and sentences or Bingo must be done in the children's homework books or on separate paper if they do not have their homework books with them.

4. **Life skills:** **Week 1-2:** **Finish** the Healthy eating and insect projects. **Week 3: New Lockdown diary** where they draw their meals and themselves as part of **Visual arts** and for integration with **English**.

5. **Lastely:** Please keep to a routine at home and divide the work equally on a daily basis, so that you or your child do not feel overwhelmed. There is an **extra document** loaded that you can use as a relaxing funtime or reward for hard work during the week. Let your child choose activities that they are most interested in which they can do over the weekends. (Stay at home package) However this is **not compulsory**.

Remember all worksheets and booklets can be punched and kept in in the given portfolio files on the last day of school for term / or if you have an extra file at home. Please just make sure that all the work done and given is kept in a safe place for returning to school as soon as we have more information, as part of our catch up programme. We as Grade 3 teachers also have separate class Whatsapp groups for support or questions. Please feel free to ask for assistance. Enjoy the time with your child and relax! We can do this if we work together as a team. Thank you for your support in advance.
