Return of other Grades on Monday 24th of August 2020

Dear Parents and Guardians

Please take note of the following arrangements:

1. All Grades except the Grade 5's will return to school on Monday the 24th of August as per latest Government Gazette. Grade 5 will return on the 31st of August.
2. A rotation system has been implemented for all Grades. This means that 50% of the learners will be at school every day to ensure that the Covid-19 regulations are taken seriously, and the required social distancing is maintained at all times. We therefore have two groups i.e. Group A and a Group B for every class. Group A will start on Monday the 24th of August as per planned attendance schedule. This plan is found on our website for your perusal.
3. The teachers will provide learners with work tasks to be completed at home for the days that they are not at school.
4. Learners in different Grades will be using different gates when they arrive at school in the morning. The following arrangements have been made:
 - Grade R and 1 learners will enter through the Grade R gate opposite to the church.
 - Grade 2 and 3 learners will enter through the gate opposite to our school hall.
 - Grade 4 to 7 learners will enter through the big gate opposite to our school hall.
 - Learners hands will be sanitised, and temperatures recorded before they are allowed to go into their register classes. Strict social distancing is to be maintained at all times.
 - Learners will stay put in one classroom while the teachers will move to the classes that they are teaching.
 - Areas have been demarcated for learners of all grades for break purposes with teachers on duty.
 - The school timetable will remain the same. All grades will finish school at the normal time i.e. as they were before lockdown.
 - Grade 3 to 7 learners will finish school every day at 13:45. Grade 1 and 2 learners finish school at 13:15 and the Grade R learners will finish school at 13:00.
 - Please ensure that all learners are picked up promptly within 15 minutes after school to ensure their safety. There are no extra mural activities in the afternoon.
5. It is important that you send a packed lunch with your child when they are at school. The school's tuckshop has been closed until further notice.
6. Parents please do not send sick children to school and ensure that your contact details are correct in the school diary so that the school can contact you in case of an emergency.

7. Learners are to please bring back to school the work done during the lockdown period.

Your cooperation is greatly appreciated. Thank you for everything you do for your children.
